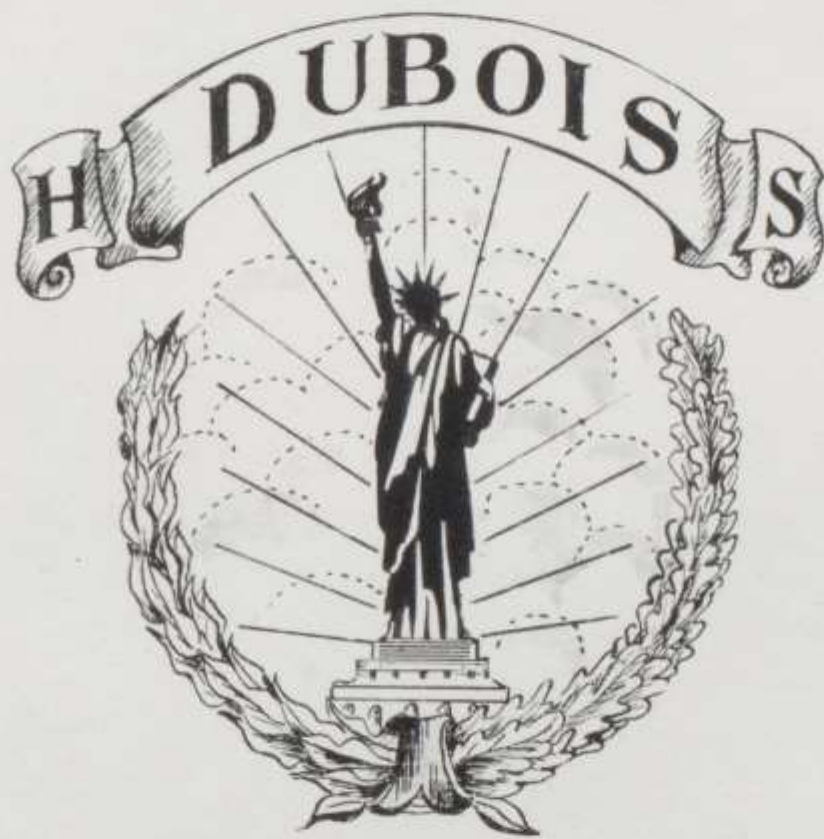

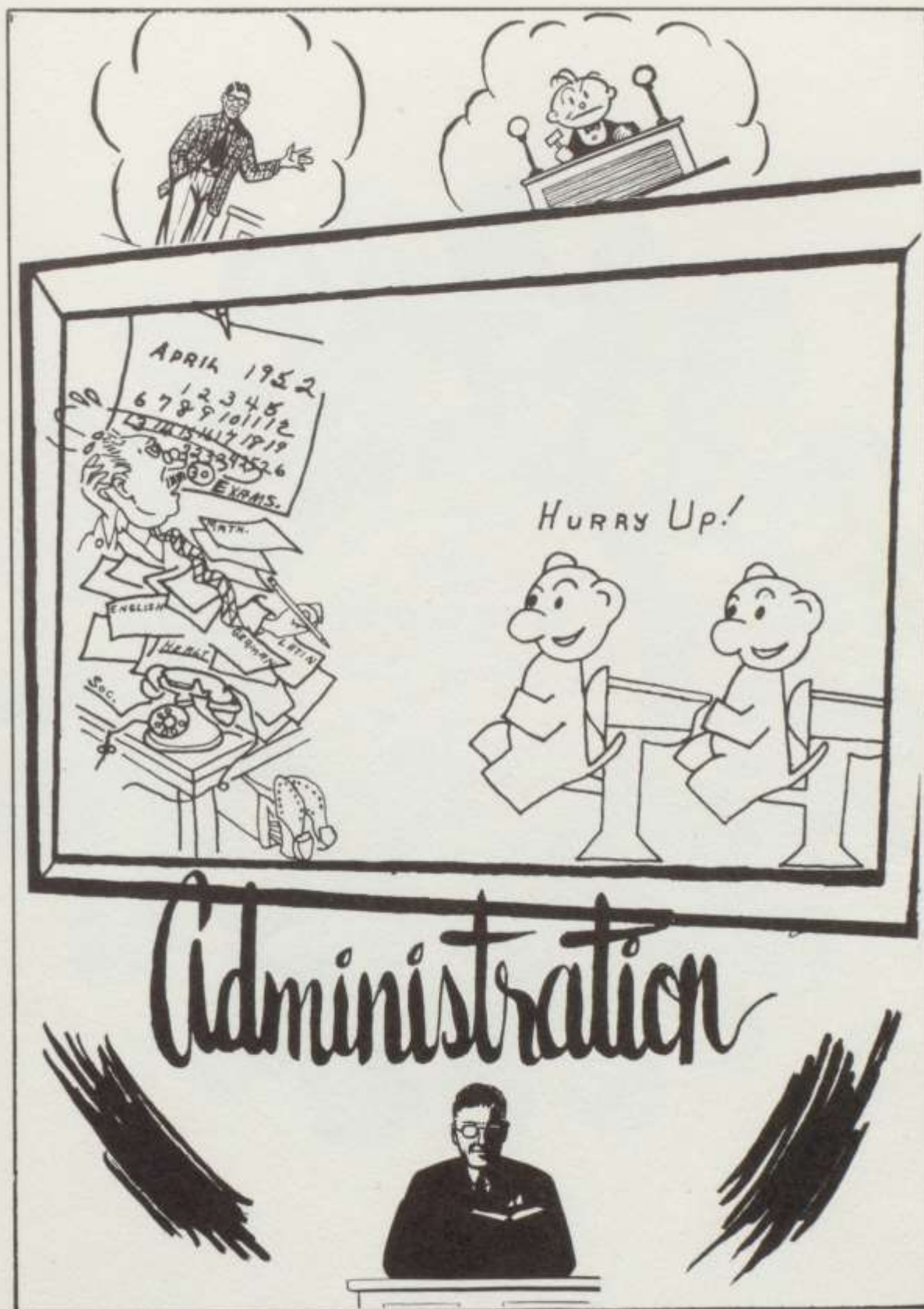

## Class History

On September 1, 1949, forty-four Freshmen crossed the threshold of a new life by entering Dubois High School. Our faculty consisted of: A. J. Kreitzer, Principal; Elmer Zehr, Social Studies; Ruth Schiller, Math; Mary Florence Seng, English and Phys. Ed.; Ralph Seger, Phys. Ed. and Commerce; Marvin McCutcheon, Science; Mavis McCutcheon, Home Economics. Mrs. McCutcheon was our class sponsor. Our class officers were: Kenneth Hall, President; Marlene Himsel, Secretary; and Herman Heeke, Treasurer. Our basketball queen attendants were Patsy Himsel and Peggy Nordhoff.

When we returned as Sophomores in 1950, John Sendelweck, Ardelia Goller, and Betty Humbert had deserted our ranks. Our number, however, had been increased by the addition of George Perkins, Lois Wineinger, Donald Blackwell, and Ronald Blackwell. The faculty's changes were: Laverta Ellis replaced Mary Florence Seng and Marilyn Walker was added as a music teacher. This year our officers were Kenneth Hall, President; George Perkins, Vice President; Mary Ellen Poe, Secretary; and Herman Heeke, Treasurer. Our Sophomore queen attendants were Patsy Himsel and Gerry Denu. At the beginning of the basketball season, Betty Fry was elected as cheerleader. Marvin McCutcheon was our class sponsor.

In 1951, at the beginning of our Junior year, Betty Fry, Ronald Blackwell, Donald Blackwell, Jack Neukam, Daniel Freyberger, Lily Mae Baer, and Wilfred Kalb failed to return. During the course of the year, we also lost Mary Lee Reckelhoff and Alice Kempf. On the debit side of the ledger, however, we gained Janice Anderson, Johnny Schott, Max Hayes, and Virlee Hostetter. In the faculty, Thelma Sater replaced Laverta Ellis; Jessie Quebbeman replaced Mavis McCutcheon; Jack Walker replaced Marvin McCutcheon; and Charlotte Coomer replaced Marilyn Walker. Junior class officers were: Marlene Himsel, President; Max Hayes, Vice-President; Mary Ellen Poe, Secretary; and Kenneth Hall, Treasurer. Yell-leaders selected from our class were Max Hayes and Johnny Schott. Marlene Himsel and Gerry Denu were chosen as basketball queen attendants. Thelma Sater was our Junior class sponsor. Some of our activities during our Junior year were selling magazines under the Curtis Plan, the Junior Carnival, Junior Class Play entitled "Life of the Party," and the Junior-Senior Prom.

We ushered in our Senior year with thirty-seven members, Lois Marie Wineinger, Peggy Nordhoff, and Donald Johnson failing to return. Our class sponsor was Elmer Zehr. Faculty changes were Barbara Price replacing Jessie Quebbeman; Aaron Parks taking Jack Walker's place; and Roy Chapman was added as English teacher. Marie Senninger replaced Charlotte Rasche after the first semester; however, an accident prevented her return and Esther Lasher completed the year as music director. Class officers were Kathryn Braun, President; George Perkins, Vice-President; Marlene Himsel, Secretary; and Kenneth Hall, Treasurer. Roy Chapman directed our class play, "The Man Who Came to Dinner." Gerry Denu was elected basketball queen of D.H.S. Her Senior attendants were Marlene Himsel and Patsy Himsel. Queen for the Holiday Festival at Huntingburg was Marlene Himsel. Max Hayes was again a cheer leader. Baccalaureate April twenty sixth, Commencement April twenty eighth.



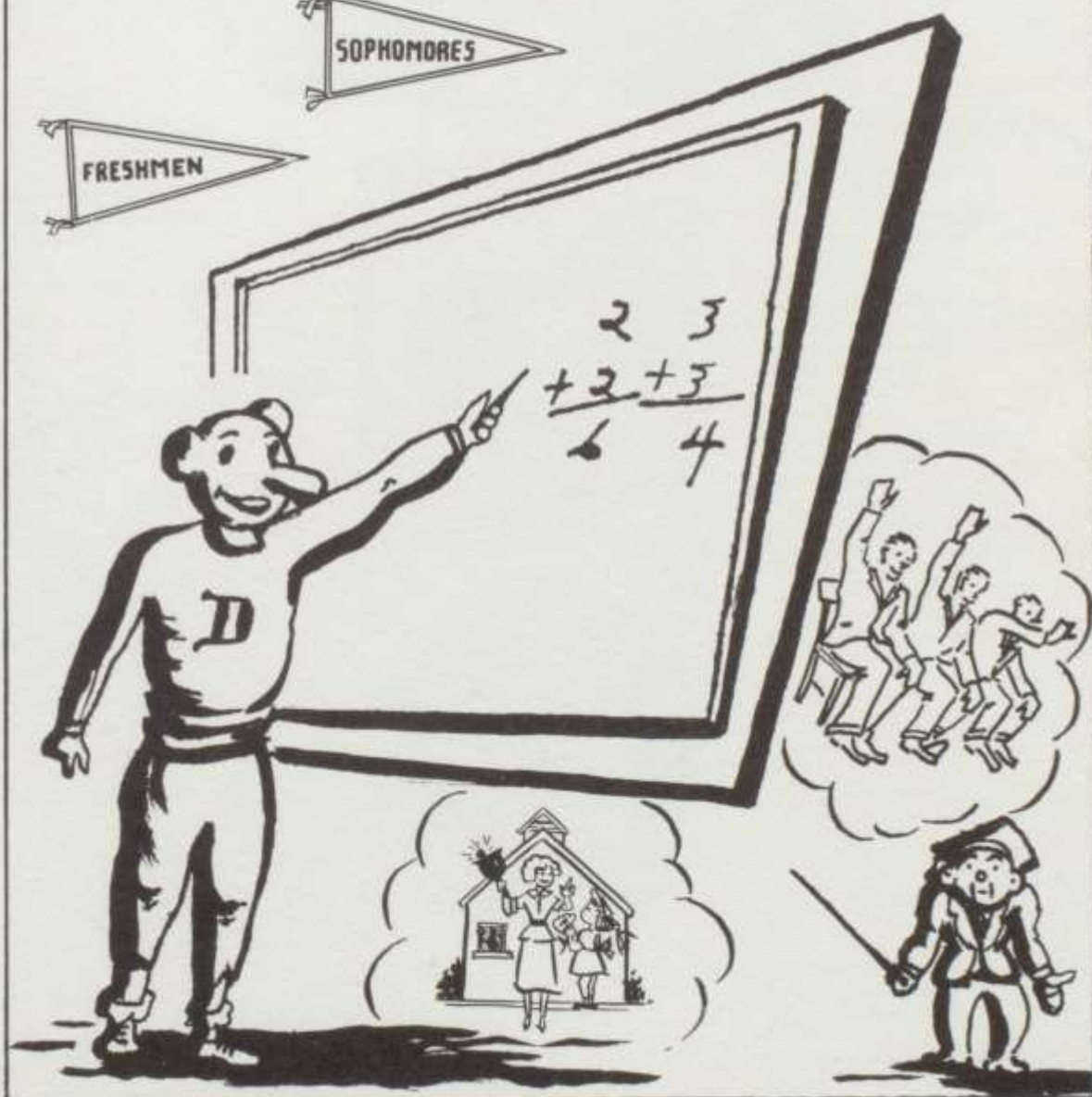
