Miss Price was our class sponsor and the Class Officers elected were as follows: President-Christian Seitz; Vice President-Wilma Voelkel; Secretary-Arlene Ziegler; Treasurer-Kenneth Mehringer; Reporters-Janice Knies and Judy Perkins.

Arlene Ziegler, from our class, was elected yell leader for the Jeeps and Judy Perkins and Carol Arvin were Second Team Yell Leaders. Judy Perkins and Harry Friedman were Carnival Queen and King and Wilma Voelkel and Joan Opel were chosen as Basketball Queen Attendants.

As Sophomores we returned to find some changes in our faculty. They were as follows: Henry Seger had replaced Roy Chapman; Mrs. Lula Seger had replaced Miss Barbara Price.

Henry Seger was our class sponsor and our class officers were as follows: President-Phyllis Baker; Vice President-Eugene Kalb; Secretary-Judy Perkins; Treasurer-Linda Buchta; Reporters-Wanda Eichmiller and Imelda Merkel.

Basketball Queen Attendants from our class were Arlene Ziegler and Joan Opel. Our class members who did not return were as follows: Kenneth Bowman, Carol Arvin, James Chastian, Paul Eddie Knies, Scott Shepard, Wilma Voelkel, Zackie Atkins, Robert Wineinger, Elmer Schroering, Kenneth Mehringer and Bob Nordhoff did not return for the second semester.



Our class officers were as follows: President-Joan Dorsam; Vice President-Gerald Terwiske; Secretary-Arlene Ziegler; Treasurer-Chris Seitz; Reporters-Chris Seitz and Mary Florence Pieper. Our Queen Attendants were Janice Knies and Shirley Bonifer.

Henry Seger was our class sponsor under whose direction we held our Carnival on October 6. He also directed our magazine campaign. On April 20, we entertained the Senior Class with a Banquet and prom at the Rustic Tavern with music furnished by Wille Bartley. Phyllis Baker was Drum Majorette for the Band.

On September 1, 1955, thirty four of us returned as Seniors.

Faculty changes were as follows: Mr. Richard Kemper replaced Mrs. Rasche, and Kenneth Riley replaced Mrs. Tolliver.

Those who did not return were: Joan Opel, Harry Friedman, and Robert Terwiske. Phyllis Baker again served as Drum Major-ette.

Some of the highlights of our Senior Year were the Band Trip to Indiana University on October 15, publishing the School Paper and Yearbook, seeing Nancy Goodman and Richard Potts crowned carnival king and queen, and presenting our Senior Class Play, HATS OFF TO GRANDMA under the direction of Henry Seger.

Shirley Bonifer was selected by the faculty to represent our class as the D.A.R. Good Citizen. Arlene Ziegler was elected to represent Dubois High School at the Christmas Festival at Huntingburg. Shirley Bonifer was elected as Basketball Queen and her attendants were Janice Knies and Nancy Goodman. She was crowned at the Shoals game on Dec. 2.

The Senior members of the Beta Club made their usual trip to Louisville to witness "A Holiday on Ice". The Prom King and Queen as selected by the Junior Class were Cletus Sermersheim and Garnet Anderson. They were crowned by John Meyer at the Banquet and Prom on April 24.

The Baccalaureate Services was held on April 22, at the gymnasium. This was followed by the Commencement April 26 at which Shirley Bonifer gave a fitting Salutatory and Christian Seitz gave a stirring Valedictory. Principal Kreitzer presented us our diplomas and we were ready to take our places among the Dubois High School Alumni.
