Class History

On August 31, 1960, fifty-four bolsterous freshmen entered the halls of Dubois High School. They were greeted by the following faculty members. A. J. Kreitzer, Principal; Elmer Zehr, Social Studies; Paul Phillips, Mathematics, Henry Seger, English and Latin; Gary Ahrens, Band and Chorus; Vinita Britzius, Home Economics; James Cawood, Commerce and Health; William Slatton, Commerce; Lester McCoy, Biology and Chemistry; Aaron Parks, Vocational Agriculture; and Wallace Thacker, Driver Education. During the year Brenda Laswell and Wilbur Seger also joined our mighty ranks. Mr. Slatton was our sponsor and under him the class officers for the first year were; Karen Stamm, President; Mike Breeding, Vice-President; Bob Kalb, Secretary; Eugene Bonifer, Treasurer; and Judy Knies, Class Reporter. We chose Kathy Hentrup and Judy Knies as Queen Attendants, and the Freshman Cheerleaders chosen were Karlyn Bauer and Karen Stamm. Richard Harder and Wilbur Seger represented Dubois at the Algebra Contest at Jasper.

In the fall of '61, we returned to find the following faculty changes; Mrs. Shirley Lythgoe and Mrs. Jorene Brewer replaced Miss Britzius, while Larry Backer filled in the first semester for Mr. McGoy. We also discovered that five of our class members had departed from our halls, but we gladly welcomed Cyrilla Matheis, Clarissa Merkel, and Sharon Gehlhausen. Mr. Phillips was our sponsor for the next hectic year. Our class officers were Richard Harder, President; Gary Leistner, Vice-President; Donna Eisenhut, Secretary; Judy Knies, Treasurer; and Connie Eisenhut and Ken Ziegler, Class Reporters. Karen Stamm was chosen as Junior Varsity Cheerleader. Again Judy Knies and Kathy Hentrup were Queen Attendants.

When after four months of vacation the class gathered together again, we met these new faculty members: Miss Marilyn Cossler replacing Mr. Seger; Miss Lois Smith replacing Mrs. Lythgoe; and a new teacher, Miss Carrie Robling. Karen Stamm, Sharon Gehlhausen, and Eugene Sendelweck attended the Regional English Contest at Huntingburg. We found that three of our class members were no longer with us. Mr. Phillips tolerated our class for one more year as sponsor with the assistance of Cyrilla Matheis, President; Clarissa Merkel, Vice-President; Richard Harder, Secretary; Karen Stamm, Treasurer; and Kathy Hentrup and Kathy Zehr, Class Reporters. Our Royalty consisted of Donnie Vaughn and Kathy Hentrup, Junior Carnival King and Queen; and Kathy Hentrup and Cyrilla Matheis, Queen Attendants. Under the direction of Miss Cossler we presented our Junior Class Play, "Honey In The Hive." The last event of the school year was the Junior-Senior Prom and Banquet at which we entertained the Senior Class. During the summer Ken Ziegler, Eugene Bonifer, and Rosemary Pieper represented D. H. S. at Hoosier Boys' State and Girls' State, respectively.

With the arrival of fall we once more plodded in the hallowed doors of D. H. S. greeted by a substantial change in faculty: Mr. Rex May replacing Mr. Cawood; Mr. Cecil Goff replacing Mr. Slatton; Miss Lynn Moss added as a new teacher; Miss Nancy McBride taking the place of Mr. McCoy; and Mr. James Pfeister replacing Miss Robling. We discovered that three more fellow students had left our class. Mr. Zehr was our patient class spensor, and class officers were Richard Harder, President; Cyrilla Matheis, Vice-President; Bob Kalb, Secretary; Donnie Vaughn, Treasurer; and Eugene Sendelweck and Jim Wininger, Class Reporters. We were glad to welcome John Kalb into our class. On November 1 and 3 we presented our Class Play under the direction of Miss Cossler. Title; "The Atomic Blonde." Cyrilla Matheis was elected Basketball Queen for 63-64 with Donna Whittinghill and Judy Knies as attendants. Rosemary Pieper received the D. A. R. Good Citizen Award. Donnie Vaughn and Kathy Hentrup reigned as King and Queen of the Junior-Senior Prom and Banquet. The Baccalaureate Service was held May 10, followed by Commencement on May 13, 1964 at which time Karen Stamm gave the Valedictory address and Ken Ziegler the Salutatory address. Thus after four years of memories, our high school days were ended and once more we passed through the doors of D. H. S., this time never to return.



"Honey in the Hive"

The Junior Class presented "Honey in the Hive" May 3 and 5, 1963. The story was about the Masons, a down-to-earth American family made up of John, the head of the house; Janet, the real head of the house; Betty Lou, a fifteen year old aspiring debutante; Connie, a seventeen year old future college coed; and Wilbur, a thirteen year old atom bomb.

The remaining characters include Bernadine Smith, a friend of Betty Lou; Suzanne Coday, "dotter" of V. Hamilton Coday; Wilbur's arch enemy, Arthur Coday; Roger Coday, a spoiled "lady killer"; Mr. Coday, a political boss and owner of the town; Mrs. Coday, arrogant and the very epitome of fashion; Mr. and Mrs. Davis, middle-aged, and all around "good people"; and Mrs. Allen, fond of recipes, is the "salt of the earth."
