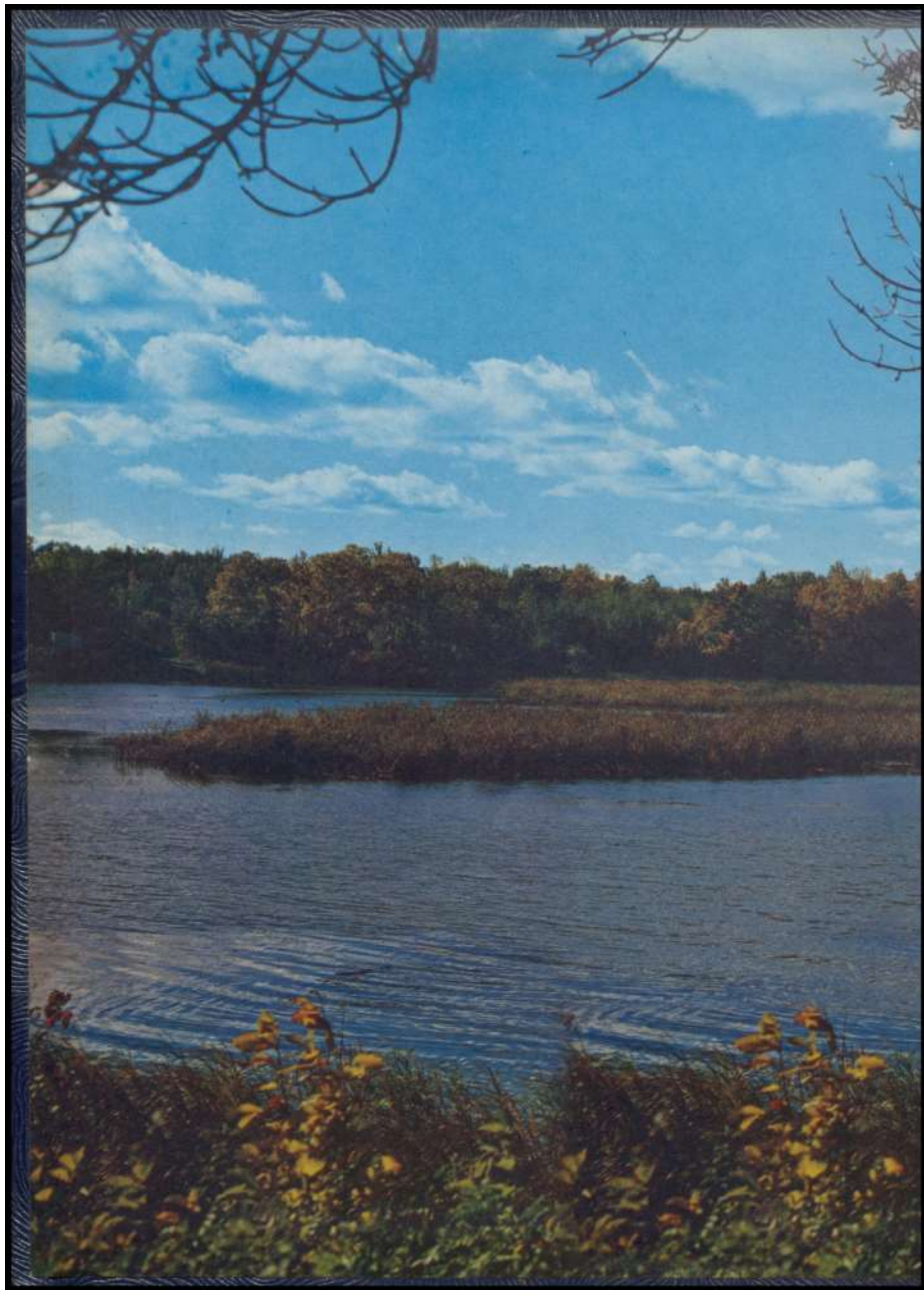
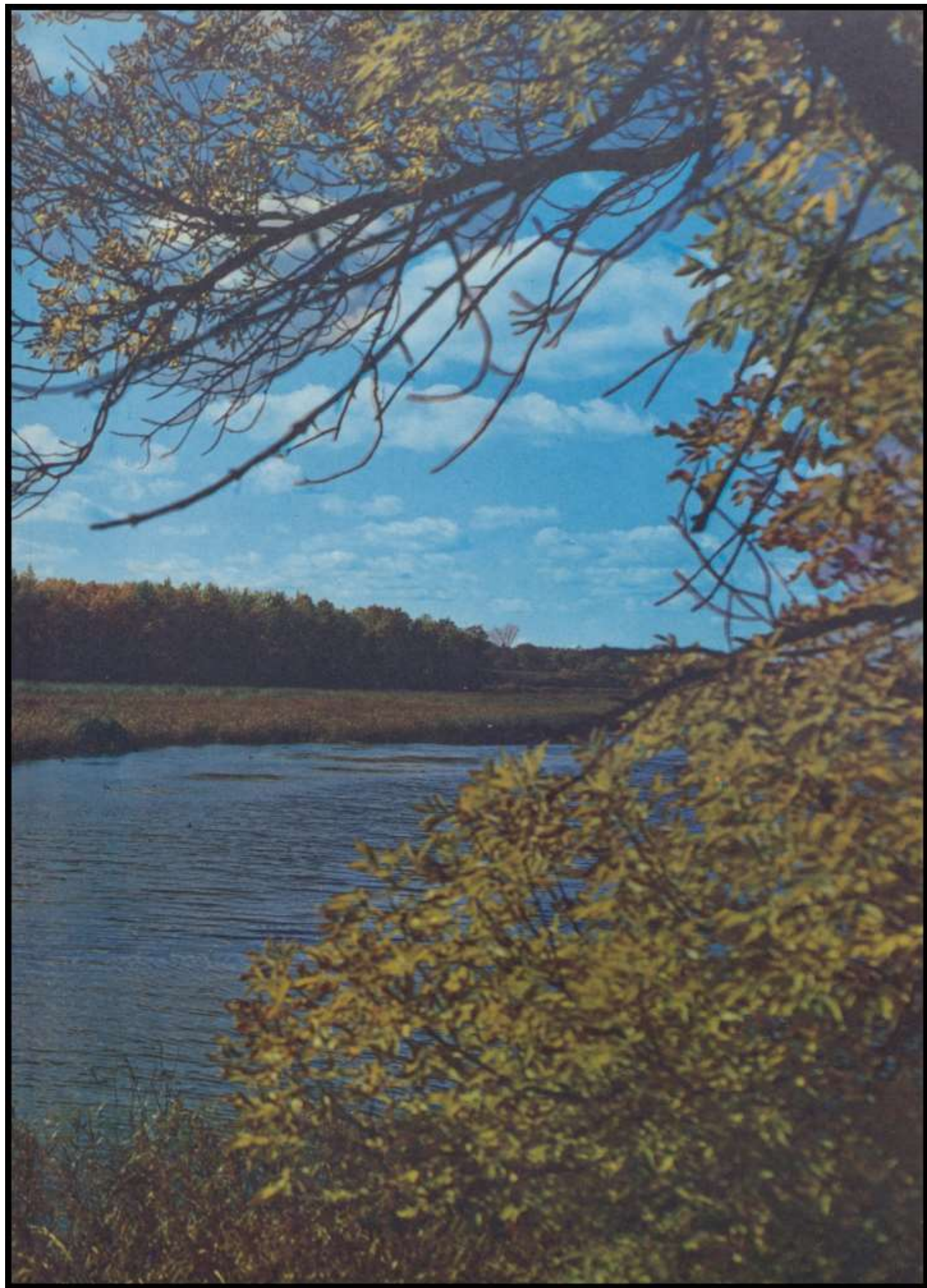

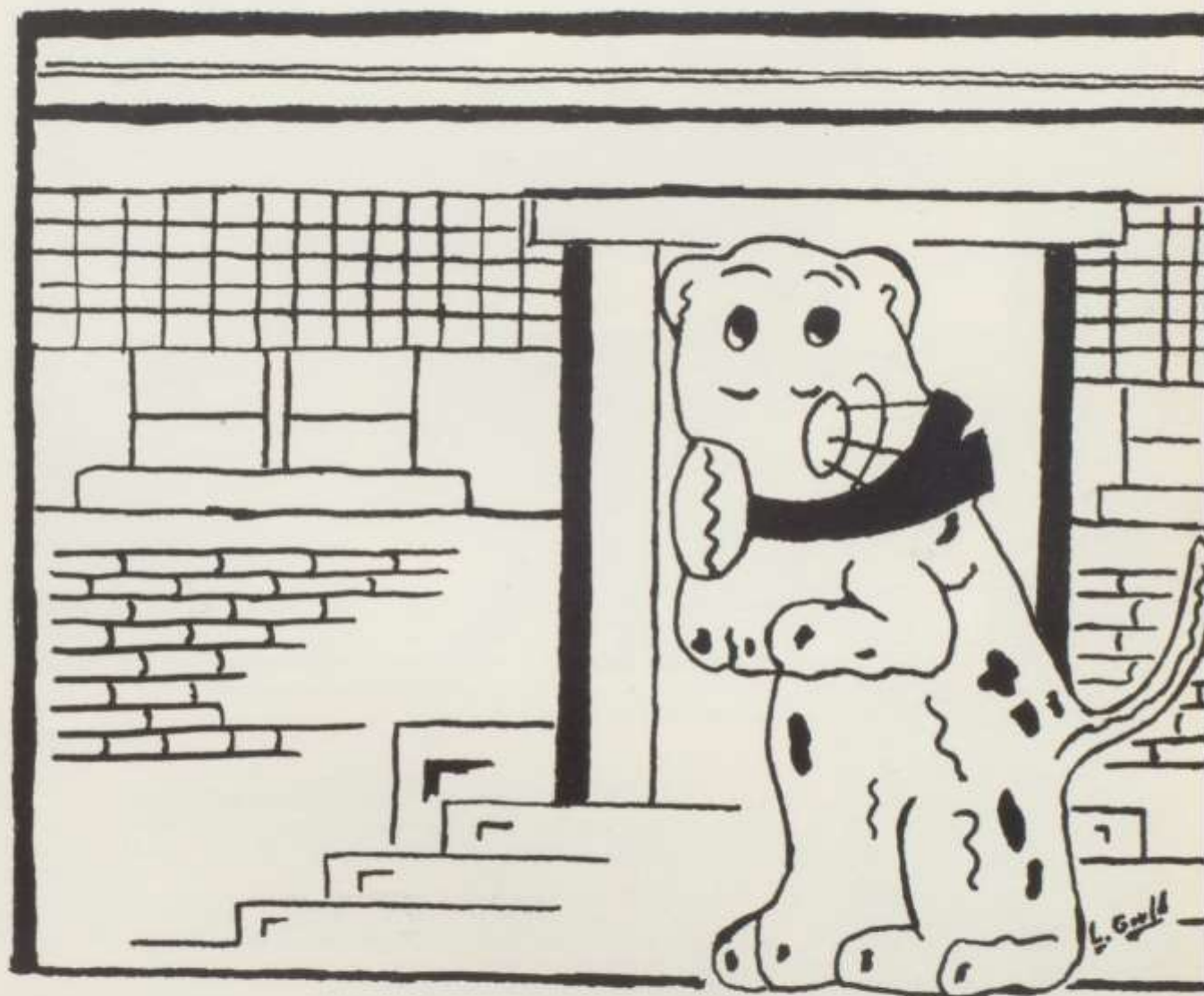

Eugene Neukam and Jean Jones were chosen Carnival King and Queen candidates and Cheryl Bair and Andrea Matheis were Queen Attendants.

At the end of the school year we lost Betty Hasenour, Sophia Birk, Larry Bair, and Barry Krodell.

In the fall of '62 the Sophomores returned to find that we had three new classmates: Margaret Beyke, Linda Theising, and Elizabeth Seger.

Mr. Slatton was once more our sponsor and class officers were: President, Eugene Neukam; Vice-President, Alan Matheis; Secretary, Cheryl Bair; Treasurer, Diana Kreitzer; Reporters, Janie Mimlitz and Susie Bauer.

Eugene Neukam and Cheryl Bair were Carnival King and Queen candidates. Cheryl Bair and Andrea Matheis were again Queen Attendants.

After the end of the school year we lost Elizabeth Seger, Eddie Neukam, and we gained Madonna Cooper.

In our Junior year we found a substantial change in faculty. Mr. Carl May replacing Mr. Cawood; Mr. Cecil Goff replacing Mr. Slatton; Miss Nancy McBride replacing Mr. McCoy; Mr. James Pfeister replacing Miss Robling; and Miss Lynn Moss.

Mr. Phillips was our sponsor and class officers were: President, Eugene Neukam; Vice-President, Cheryl Bair; Secretary, Janie Mimlitz; Treasurer, Alan Matheis; Reporters, Susie Bauer, Rosie Hemmerlein, and Karen Zehr.

Eugene Neukam and Cheryl Bair were crowned Junior Carnival King and Queen. Cheryl Bair and Diana Kreitzer were chosen Queen Attendants.

Janie Mimlitz and Carol Lansford were Varsity Cheerleaders from our class.

Under the direction of Miss Cossler we gave our Junior Class Play, "That's Our Boy."

Eugene Neukam and Lance Conner represented us at Boys' State and Cheryl Bair at Girls' State.

Our last event of the year was to entertain the Seniors at the Junior-Senior Prom.

During the year we lost Andrea Matheis, Diana Kreitzer, and Richard Zehr.

With the arrival of fall we entered the halls of D.H.S. for our final year. Mr. Zehr was our class sponsor and class officers were: President, Lance Conner; Vice-President, Barbara Looney; Secretary, Janie Eisenhut; Treasurer, Janie Mimlitz; Reporters, Cheryl Bair and Rosie Hemmerlein.
