


All Stars


























Never Say Goodbye PROM




















Boys' Tennis




- 1. Their defeat of Loogootee during regular season was the first in 20 years.

And in closing, we want to express that each member of this team played a key part in the many fine achievements of the 1986-87 Northeast Dubois Basketball Program.



This years track team was young and inexperienced but yet, the varsity track team compiled a record of 25-5-1. The junior varsity ended their season with a record of 16-0.


Highlights of the season were as follows:
