Disney Spectacular 1987

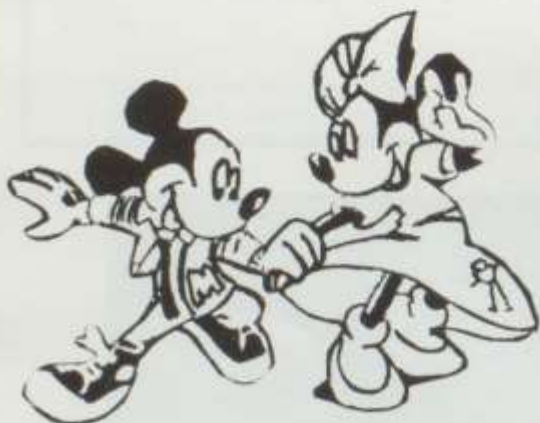

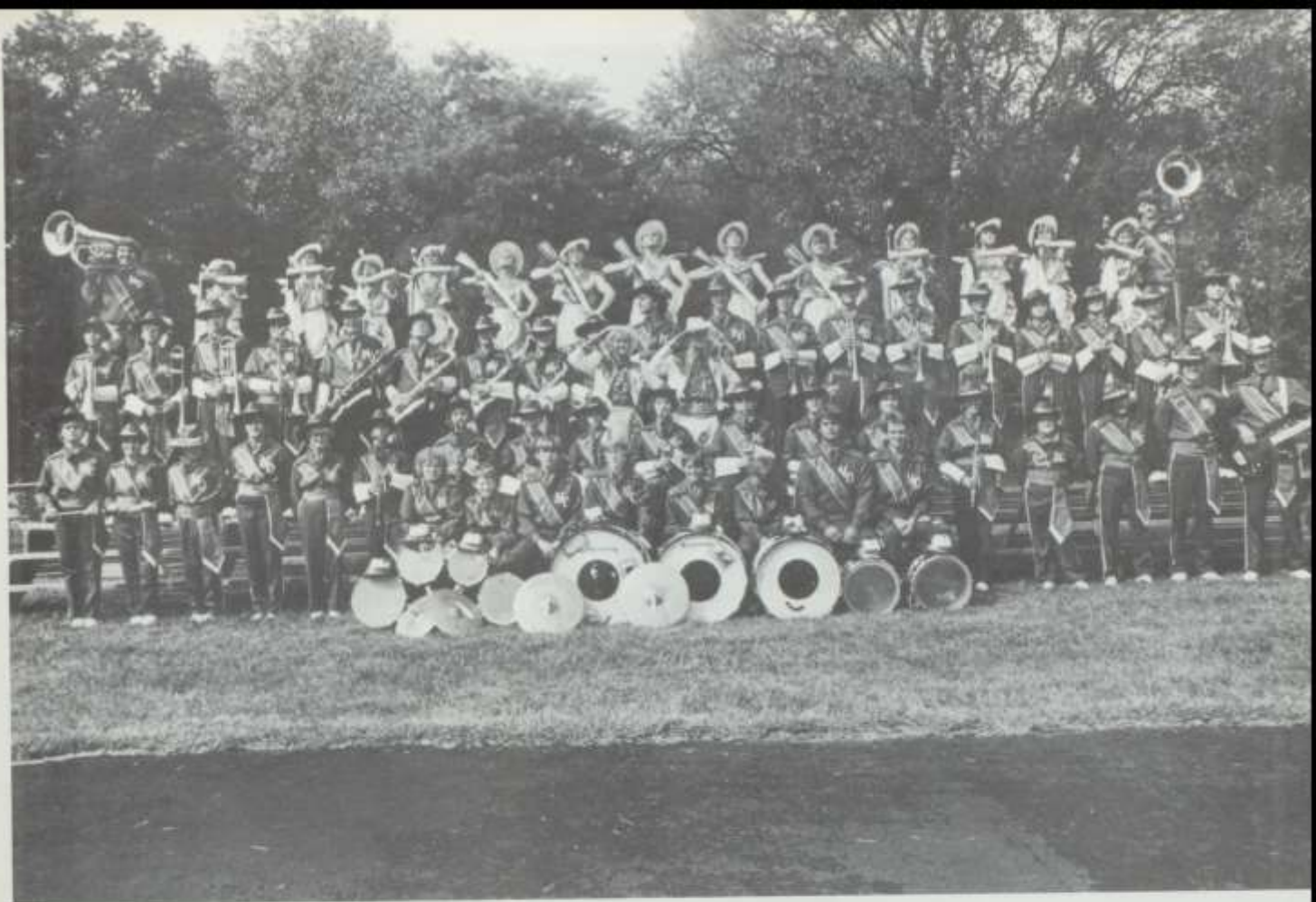

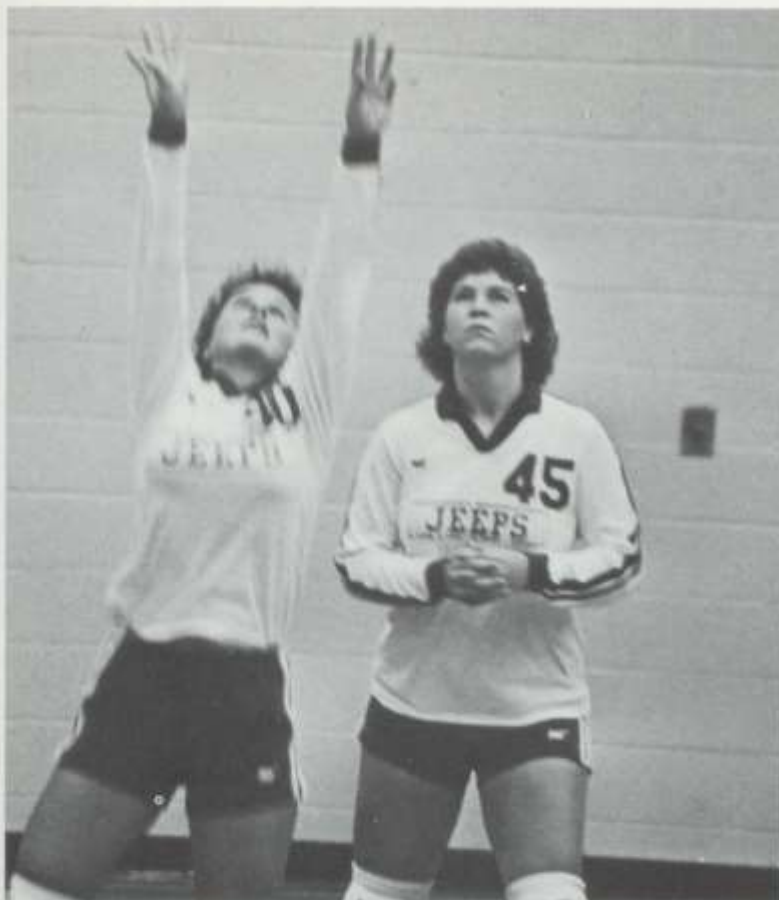
