Alves J. Kreitzer, a local store owner in Dubois (who would later become the coach of the basketball team) purchased a miniature Jeep in St. Louis, and it became the team mascot.



The first game played as the Jeeps was played at Shoals on November 6, 1936. The 1937-38 season brought a mark of 18-5, and the Jeep mascot was here to stay.
