Sister Johnette, the Junior girls' homeroom teacher, spends most of her time in the band room. Her talents are greatly expressed by the progress shown in the music department.

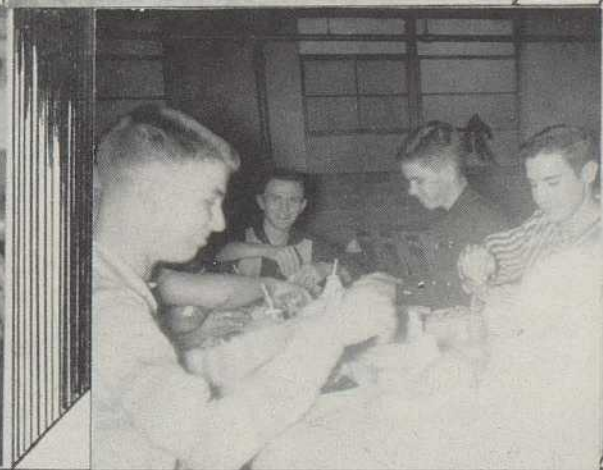

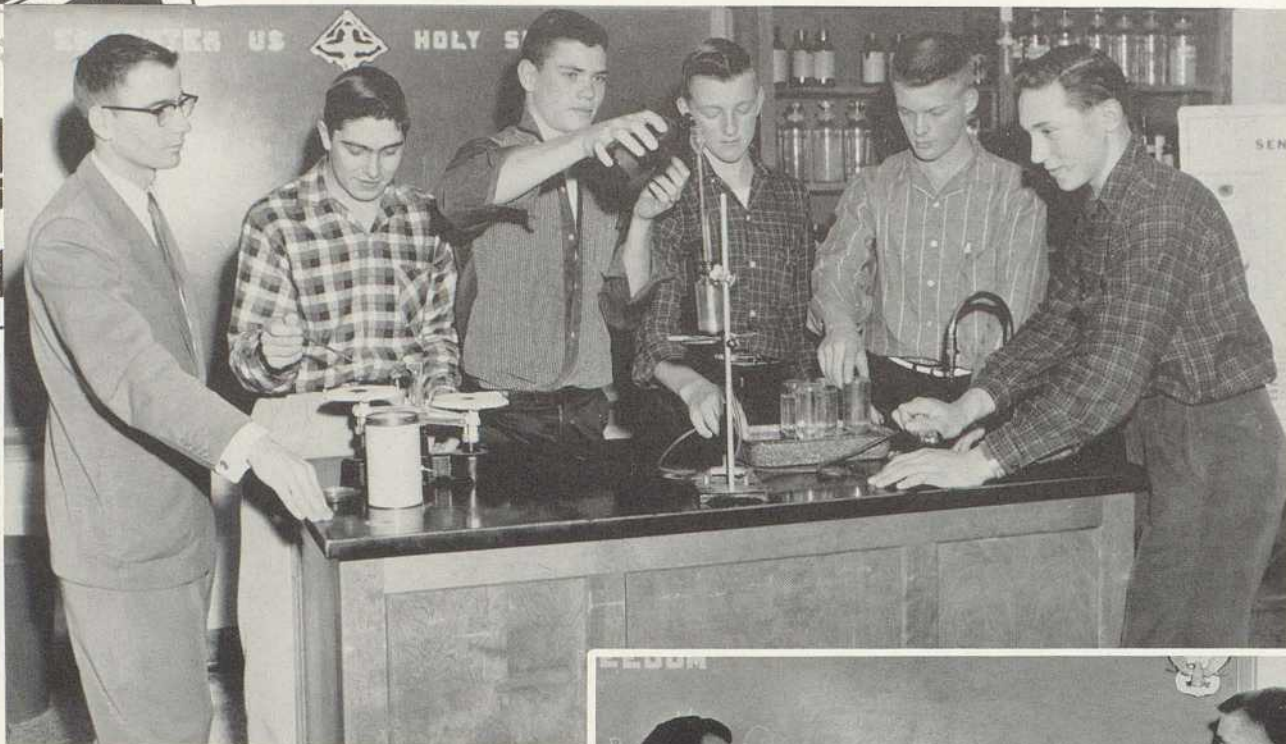
