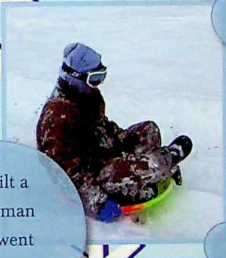
# SNOW DAYS

## 3D Printing

3D printing uses a printer to build objects layer by layer with plastic or resin. A print bed holds the object, while extruder's or lasers shape it. Software and motors control the process, and fans help cool. After printing, tools like sanders or UV lights finish the job.

We primarily manufacture tool holders for Jasper Engines, while also producing custom award holders, with a focus on quality, precision, and innovation.

Embroidery is the art of stitching images onto fabric using needle and thread. Whether done by hand or machine, each design follows a pattern, bringing intricate visuals to life through careful, creative stitching.

Embroidery is used to make art, clothes, patches, and home decor.



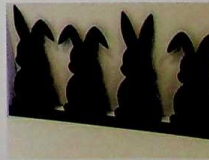
## Shirt Printing

Shirt printing is when you put a picture on a shirt. One way is to push ink through a screen with holes in the shape of the design. Another way is to print directly onto the shirt like a regular printer, and sometimes heat is used to stick the design on the shirt.



## Plasma Cutter

A plasma cutter is a tool that cuts metal using super-hot gas. It melts the metal with a plasma arc, a kind of super-heated lightning, then blows the melted metal away, leaving a clean cut. It's fast, works on lots of metals, and is easy to use for cutting thick or thin metal pieces.

ALVES J. KREITZER, A LOCAL STORE OWNER IN DUBOIS (LATER COACH) PURCHASED A MINIATURE JEEP IN ST. LOUIS AND IT BECAME THE TEAM MASCOT. THE FIRST GAME PLAYED AS "JEEPS" WAS PLAYED AT SHOALS ON NOVEMBER 6, 1936. THE JEEPS WON THE GAME 29-21 AND WENT ON TO ESTABLISH A 17-4 RECORD THAT SEASON. THE 1937-38 SEASON BROUGHT A MARK OF 18-5 AND THE JEEP MASCOT WAS HERE TO STAY.
