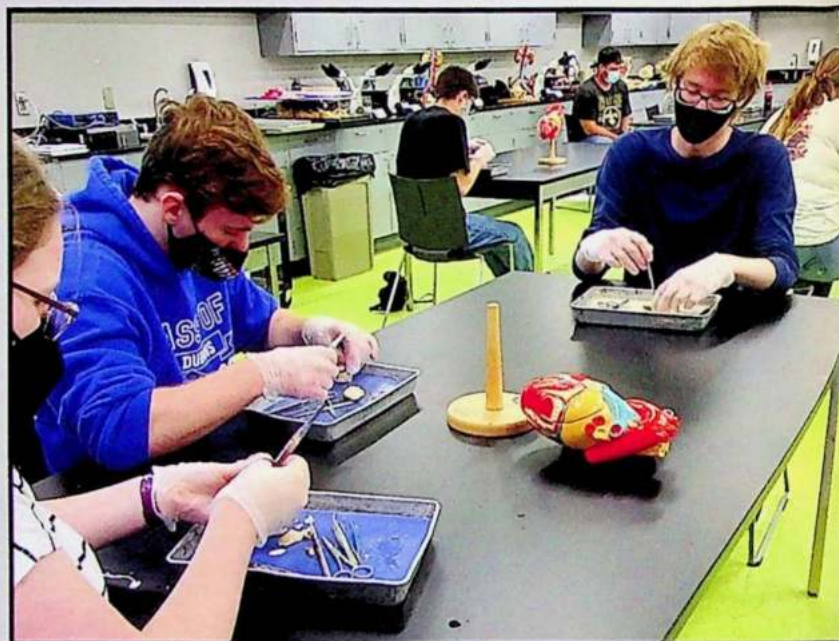

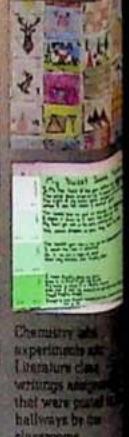
Mario's Journey
