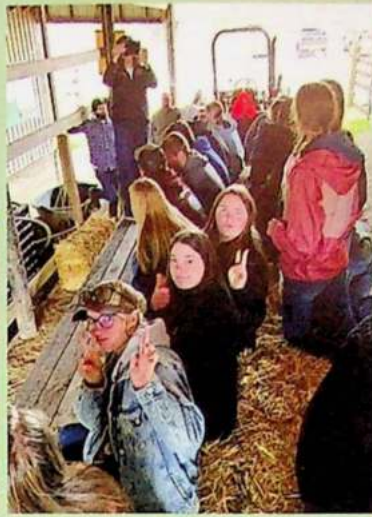
Field Trips
