Mrs. Tina Terwiske's IED class took a trip to VU and they got to 3D print a key chain, work with 3D scanners and toured VU.



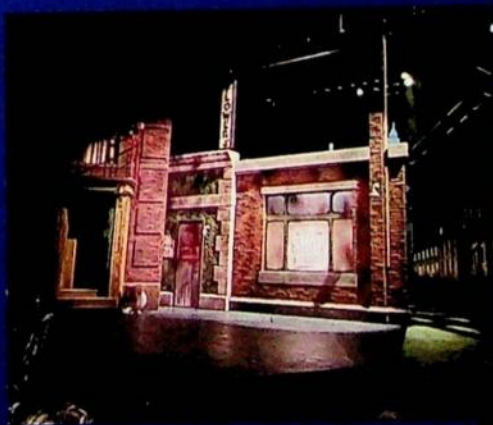
Ag Olympics

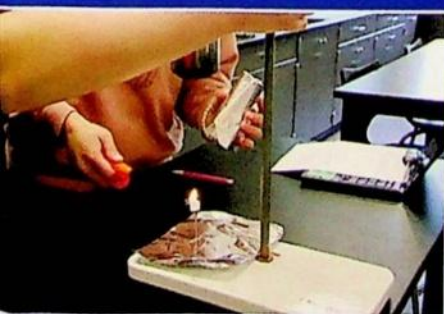

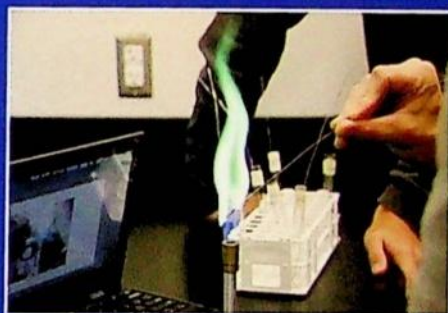

The Show in the Sky

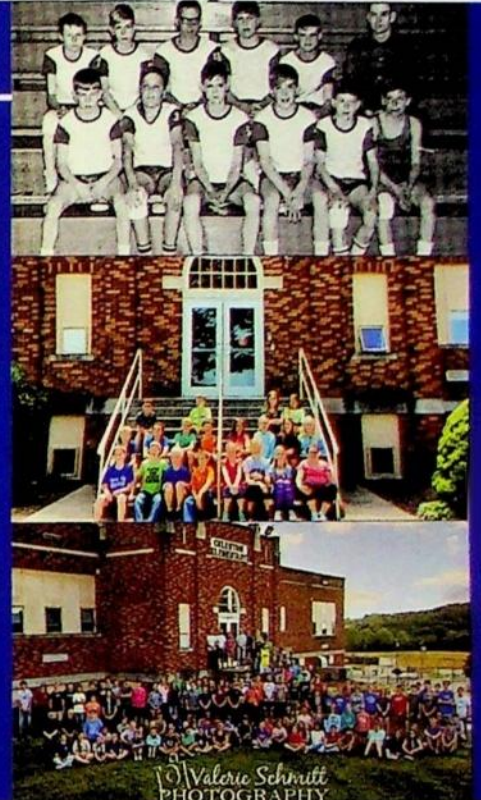
On April 8th, 2024 a total solar eclipse passed through the town of Dubois and surrounding areas. A solar eclipse is when the moon passes through the path of the earth and the sun, obscuring the view of the sun. The last solar eclipse in Southern Indiana was August 7th, 1869, and the next total solar eclipse will not happen in the USA until August 3rd, 2044. This will only be a partial one for Indiana. The weekend of the 10th, 11th, 12th of May,

Dubois was able to see the Northern Lights. The Northern Lights are sparked by coronal mass ejections, or explosions of plasma and magnetic material shooting out of the sun, colliding with Earth's magnetic field. Dubois saw them due to a severe solar storm.



Celestine Elementary

In 1905 an agreement between Rev. Charles Bilger of the St. Celestine Church and Ignatz Friedman, Trustee of Hall Township, allowed a two school room on the church property for 12 dollars a year. The school closed, due to bus transportation, and in 1920 a new four room building was erected, only two used by the school. 1941, the building had caught fire destroying the school, the school moved to a temporary building nicknamed the "chicken house" as the new school was under construction. A new bus route was given to Joseph Pieper in 1956, this gave the children of Celestine School a chance to attend Dubois High School. Also in 1956, the school was expanded to four rooms, and then four years later to five. By 1963, Celestine was the only school in Hall Township remaining, and by 1967 the school had finished expanding. 53 years later, in 2020, Celestine was closed down due to financial issues and by 2023 it was torn down. Although the school is no longer standing, the spirit and pride of the Celestine School lives on through the streets of Celestine.
